Lost to us on May 5, 2006, this twenty-four year-old Little Ferry resident was a larger than life figure to those who were blessed to know him.

Fatally injured while conducting combat operations in Iraq, Sgt. Fenton's service to our Country shall not be forgotten.

The twenty-four year old Little Ferry resident is a symbol of hope and valor within our community, and this 5K Run/Walk is only a small token of our appreciation for him.

At his funeral, Sgt. Fenton was made an honorary Little Ferry Police Officer, the job he was to hold upon his return to Little Ferry.

Sgt. Fenton was with the Forces Reserve's Inspector and Instructor Staff, 1st Battalion, 25th Marine Regiment, 4th Marine Division Fort Devens, Massachusetts.

Directions:

From the West:

I-80 East to exit 64 US-46 East. Merge on US-46 East via the ramp on the left. Continue on US-46 past Teterboro Airport and take slight right after Dunkin Donuts to Main St. Continue on Main St through one light. Event will be straight ahead.

From NYC and North:

Lincoln Tunnel to 495 West. Merge onto I 95 North toward US-46. Take US-46 exit toward THE RIDGEFIELDS/PALISADES PARK. Merge onto US-46 W toward RIDGEFIELD PARK. Continue to circle; continue around circle to exit right onto Bergen Tpke. Continue on Bergen Tpke to Main St.

From the East:

I-280 East to merge onto I-95 N. Keep right to take I-95 N toward US-46/FORT LEE. Merge onto US-46 W toward RIDGEFIELD PARK. Follow directions from NYC and north above.
